

Repertoire List Assignment

The purpose of this assignment is to compile a comprehensive list of musical repertoire that you have studied and/or performed during your years of formal study. This list could be presented to a new voice teacher, a university, or a professional arts organization.

Organize the titles of your songs categorically by style or language. Use the following headings.

- Renaissance of Medieval songs
- Italian songs
- German lieder
- French chanson
- Operatic arias (not including early Italian arias) –any language
- Oratorio Arias – any language
- Classical English songs
- Classical American songs
- Traditional Musical Theater (pre-1970)
- Modern Musical Theater (post-1970)
- Jazz standards
- Original compositions (include self-composed songs)
- Major choral works (list solos, duets, quartets, if any)

Establish a series of columns under your category headings from left to right as follows:

Title (of song)

Include whether the song is extracted from a larger work
Use exact title of song

Composer (last name is sufficient)

Semester & Year (first studied or performed, e.g., Fall 2002)

List chronologically from present to past
